Bus

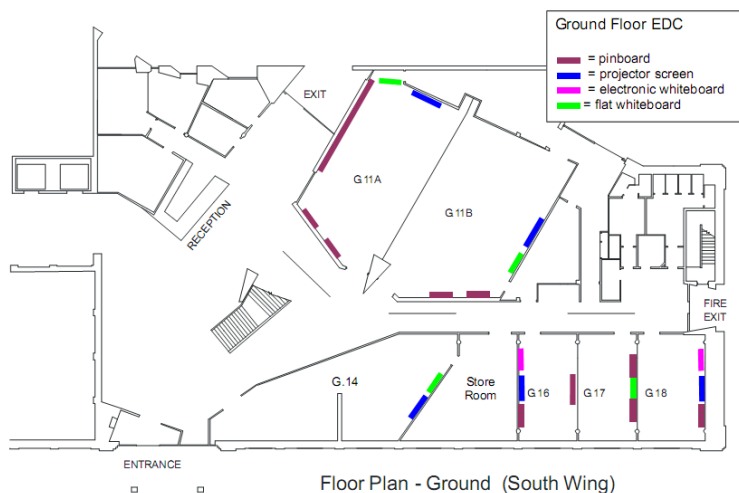
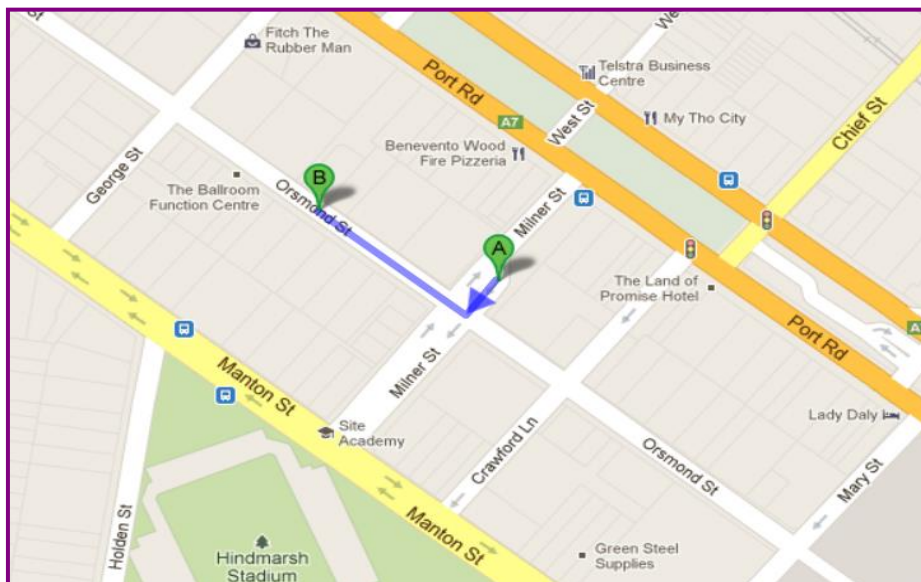
Bus numbers: 150/155/157 from North Terrace leaving the city every 15 minutes to **STOP 7** on Port Road.
