National Partnership (NP) More Support Students with Disabilities (MSSD)

Online Training was one strategy from the South Australian Department for Education National Partnership MSSD.

There are six courses

- Understanding Autistic Spectrum Disorders
- Understanding Dyslexia and Significant Difficulties in Reading
- Inclusion of students with Speech Language and Communication Needs
- Understanding Motor Coordination Difficulties.
- Understanding and Supporting Behaviour
- Understanding Hearing Loss

The courses:

- Are developed from evidence based interventions and best practice
- Are blended learning experiences – a combination of face to face and independent online learning
- Are conducted over 10 - 12 weeks, led by a trained tutor
- Consist of 3 face to face sessions, each approximately 3 hours in duration
- Provides opportunities for discussion and resource sharing during face to face sessions
- Are aimed at classroom teachers, however SSOs can participate if accompanied by a teacher they work closely with. Site leaders are encouraged to participate
- Teachers can become tutors after completion of the course and the tutor training session, and agreement from their Principal
- Participants can complete several of the courses but only one at a time.

Approximate time span of the courses:

- 2 weeks between sessions 1 and 2, 3 to 4 weeks between sessions 2 and 3, 2 weeks between session 3 and completion date.
