**Support the student's individual needs, learning and their interests**

**Flexible system**

**Student growth**

**Build capacity in the system**

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## The IESP

Replaced the Disability Support Program (DSP) in 2019

### The 'Old Model'

- Fixed funding
- Rigid
- Based on a diagnosis
- No requirement for a personalised plan



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## The IESP

Is a Reform *not* a Process Change

### The Concept

- No site/student would be worse off
- Focussed on the student's functional needs
- Personalised learning plan
- Evidence based adjustments
- Applications were to be moderated by a statewide panel of 'experts'
- Regular reviews
- Sliding scale of support



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## The IESP

### Reform *not* a Process Change

#### Benefits

- Linked to the One Plan
- Based on diagnosis + data + plan
- Provided support from Preschool to end of schooling



## The IESP

### Reform *not* a Process Change

#### Benefits

- IESP Grant
- 9 categories of support
- Support for preschool children 8 hours+
- Online process
- Review dates



## The IESP

### Reform *not* a Process Change

#### Features

- Skill building
- Growth
- Independence
- Personalised plan
- Individual's strengths & interests
- Transition points
- Post School
- Capacity Building staff and schools



## The IESP

### Reform *not* a Process Change

#### Improvements

- Greater support and training for sites
- Training for Support Services
- Four week turnaround for panel outcomes
- Levels of support for students transitioning from preschool
- Sites becoming more experienced and comfortable in the process
- Better applications – evidence based adjustments, focus on specific skill development, specialist informed

- Continued targeted support of sites, partnerships
- Responsive and flexible responses when required
